






1 F CIQ Area

The first place where cruise passengers step into when the ships dock, the CIQ Area can process 4,000 passengers within 2 hours.







During the off-season or whenever it is not used for cruise ships, this space can be transformed into event venues for trade fairs, exhibitions, concerts, dance performances, or kids' sports events.

Two pillars are decorated with 8 impressive works by leading artisans of iconic Ishikawa crafts such as Kutani porcelain ware, Kaga Yuzen dyed silk, and lacquerware from Wajima, Yamanaka, and Kanazawa.

The layout is designed to allow all guests to enjoy the panoramic view of the sea while they satisfy their tastebuds with locally-sourced ingredients.




The most popular attraction is this simulator which is the largest in Japan, comprised of 14 monitors, each one measuring 70 inches.


